Back at Callaway we settled into another late happy hour in their bar off the lobby that topped off our excellent adventure of the day.

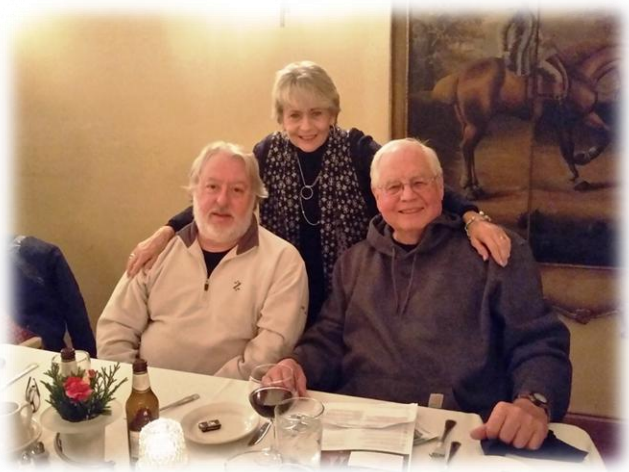

26 members had a great time so if in the future we have an event please consider joining us. We are about the cars but that just brought us together. We stay together because of the folks!

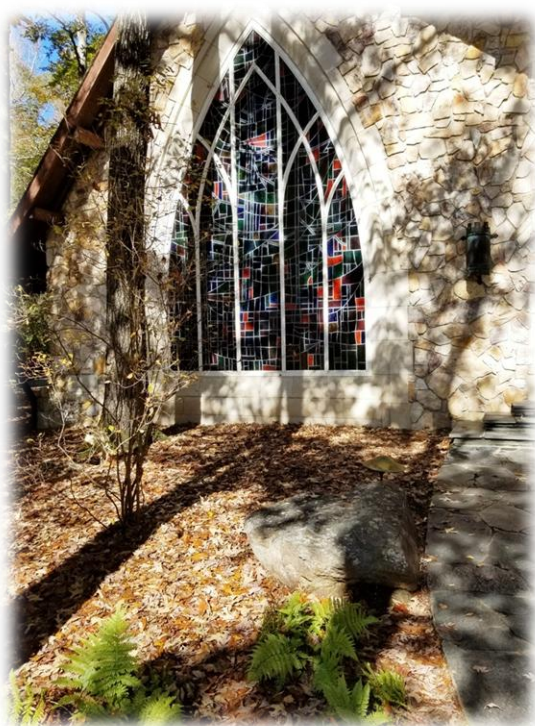
